(Luke 10:30-37)

...notice the pain of others.

“But a Samaritan, as he traveled, came where the man was; and when he saw him, he took pity on him.”
vs. 33 (NIV)

“I look for someone to come and help me, but no one gives me a passing thought!” Psalm 142:4 (NLT)

...get close to them.

“The Samaritan went to him...” vs. 34a (NCV)

“In all their troubles, He was troubled, too. He didn't send someone else to help them. He did it Himself, in person.”
Isaiah 63:9a (Msg)

...do the things I can do.

“...(he) bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. Then he put the man on his own donkey, brought him to an inn and took care of him.”
vs. 34b (NIV)

“There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work.”
1 Corinthians 12:6 (NIV)

...invest for the long term.

“The next day, the Samaritan brought out two coins, gave them to the innkeeper, and said, ‘Take care of this man. If you spend more money on him, I will pay it back to you when I come again.’”
